

Portland June 15. 1857

Mr Hibbard

Dear Sir

I have bought my Fathers  
covered Carriage that is at Sanford and I  
want to get it to Portland this week if I  
can and I did not know but the best way  
would be to get you to take it down for  
me if you was coming to Portland  
this week and if you will take it  
down for me and not get it rubeed  
I will pay you \$125 this is the same it would  
cost me by rail road and if you  
cannot bring it for me I want you  
to get some one going to Mills Depot  
to take it down for me then is a Harness  
to come with it will you please put the  
Harness into a bagging and put it into  
the Carriage <sup>so it cannot get out</sup> and fix the arms so  
they will not get rubeed and mark the  
Carriage H. P. Stone Portland and tell  
the one that takes it to the Depot to tell  
Eaton to send it to me in good order  
immediately I should think any one going  
to the Depot would take it down for 25 cts  
at any rate I do not want it to cost  
to much if you will see to this I will see you paid  
H. P. Stone
