

personal estate of every description, and  
also all the real estate which I bought  
of John Waterman (excepting the hill  
above the grove which is to be deeded  
to Dr Charles & Ad. Parsons and the  
sole use and benefit of all her own  
money now at interest (about three  
hundred dollars. together with the sole  
use of the one half of all my other  
property (Notes &c) during her natural  
life. The other half I give to my  
infant son cotton Matthew Bradbury  
to be kept at interest for his support  
and Education, and all that is not  
expended for that purpose (I mean  
a classical education) to be for his  
use when he becomes of age, and the  
whole to revert to him when his mother  
has done with it. And if he should not  
live to become of age, and I have no  
other heir by her, after her decease  
the property shall revert back to my  
grand children, and if none to their  
parents in equal proportion excepting  
that part of property which she had  
at marriage shall be always at  
her own disposal.
