Sister Hannah I would say to you that we
are all well as common and I think that
I shall come down before long but if I should
not come down or should come I think
would be the best for you to sell your
Sheers if you can get a good price for
them it is possible that they may bring about
as much this fall as they would next ^{if}
hay should be cut off another season I think
it would be more profitable for you to
keep 6 or 8 ^{and 2 pens} Sheep instead of turkeys
Turkeys cause you a great many steps to
look after them and a large lot of corn
to fat them I advise you to get rid of them
