

Augusta Dec 5th 1852

Dear Sister

I now take this opportunity to write, you I am well and the rest of the folks, and I hope this will find you the same. I have bin wayting for you to write to me first and I have got tear of wayting and I thot I would try and write a little.

I have written home It has bin three weeks since I wrote them and I have not heard from them, Uncle Balsmon and aunt Rozina have bin here since I came here he sed he should be down here again this winter and he would carry me up to Sidney to see the folks and I think I shall go.

I have bin to meeting to day, I did not go this after noon because it rained to hard. I have bin to the catholye meeting once the first Sunday I was here, it was a meeting I tell you the preast went throu some drule manures, I dont know as it would be worth while to menshone them I suppose.
