

Napabboro, June 21, 1852

Dear Sir,

I have a small patch of land remaining of the Lot I bought of Thos. Dorn, on the South side of No. 19. It commenced at the West end of Dr. Johnson's land. I think what I sold him runs 12 rods from the County road, which carries his West line a little above his stable. If I am right my strip runs 8 rods farther toward the U. N. Home, but not quite up to the Main road. I sold a strip at the head of Lot No. 19, ^{Lot 19 was} divided me by Dorn running from the county road 20 rods as according to Solomon Adams's Survey) to E. N. Favor. I also sold him all of lots No. 20 & 21 not previously conveyed to the School District to Dr. Johnson. I wrote Dr. J. 2 or 3 years since to see if he would not buy it, but recd. no reply from him. My strip does not run so far South as Dr. Johnson's, as I also sold him a part of No. 20 — but mine is on the S. side of Lot 19 and includes all of that lot not conveyed by me to the Duct, or J. Hackett, or Sam. Mitchell. I am very positive I did not convey any part of Lot 19, to Favor. By looking at the record of their Deeds you will see what remains mine. I believe the strip will prove to be 8 rods long by 2 1/2 wide. I know not who has improved it — probably Dr. J.

I met with Mr. Brookway from yr. village the other day and offered it to him very low, if he would hunt it up and get you to make a deed. He concluded
