Dear Sister Lizzie

We have been waiting several weeks to get a letter from you but as yet, have been doomed to disappointment so, I'll be the first to begin. You know when a person is "looking for a letter" they "kind-or-like" to have it come along -

But I don't know as there is any neighborhood news to communicate just now tho' some changes have taken place, for instance Lavinia King has left the Lane for Kentucky, I left here Saturday last as you may have heard, is now of course somewhere on the way. Lydia Ann Beare is improving a little she thinks. I called to see her a day or two since, seemed glad to see me but said she had about made up her mind I was going to slight her.
