Dear Father I rec^d. a line from
Esq Chandler respecting some money that
he has rec^d. of Crooker I wish you to call on
Pullen and see if he has made the arrangement
respecting the new Bank if he has and things
appear as well as at the commencement you
can say to Chandler that I wish him to pay the
\$300 into the Bank and the balance to you if the
arrangement has not been made say to him
to loan the amount to the best advantage for
six months on ample security. I close my
writing class this Evening in this Town and expect
to commence the 5th next week say to Eddes
that there is no paper printed in this Town
the folks are all well as usual write me a
long letter soon.
