Sir

Two roads have been laid out on the Moxey Lands, one 12 the other 6 miles in length; when they are built we may as well abandon the land - There is considerable timber, which can be got off this winter - Mr Bay at Westford of Madison is here & wants a permit, he will pay all the timber is worth - Mr Babcock Mr Kelley you & I have a share in common, all the rest has been set off - Kelley Babcock & I are anxious to permit & get off what we can - Will you authorize Mr Farrar or somebody else to permit your interest; please answer on receipt of this & oblige
