said to me that they had no doubt if you were

There ^{are many} ~~are many~~ of the Improved Reaction whels now in use
for Grist Mills and all to the entire satisfaction of those
who use them - The whels are all cast iron and a
1/2 foot whel such as I presume you would want would
weigh about 500 lbs and could be cast and ready
to ship as soon as the Buckets for the spiral whel
could be ready, and they can be put in operation with
much less expense than those whels, and I will warrant
them to give perfect satisfaction - And I would send
you a circular ^{who is well acquainted with the business} ~~wright~~ to put them in operation which
should cost you no more than a circular ~~wright~~ there
should you conclude to have one or more whels for
your Grist Mills or for any other Machinery the Patent
Right would be 25¢ a whel provided they prove what they
are represented to be, that is provided they prove satisfactory
