

Monson May 26th 1859

Ever dear Husband

To day with much pleasure I received & read your
your very kind & acceptable letter bearing date 12^{inst} - you write
that your health is as good as common that leaves me to doubt that
you do not enjoy very good health, will you not be more particular
in your next & write me what the real state of your health is:
you know suspense is uncomfortable to bear, or if it is so for one
I wait for a full explanation of the word common

To day I have spent the Sabbath at home as I have every other
since you left ~~home~~ with the exception of one I spent at As
the most of our family have attended meeting to day, but have
had no preaching, expect your privilege is greater & hope you
will be much profited & enjoy the consolations of the dear
redeemer wherever duty calls you to go, & may His grace ever be
sufficient for you - whether we shall have much preaching
here this season or not is at present uncertain -

yesterday & day before was quite rainy to day has been quite pleasant
& I have been down here this afternoon were glad to hear from
you, & their Father's family, send much respects to you all
I think it would do them good if they could only see how
smart & well I is, she is expecting a visit from them this the
coming fall - I shall omit writing any more at present shall

spent the day & night with him, returned this morning
let me go where I will there is something missing I feel
lonely - this is the fourth day since it commenced raining
