

Kendalls Mills 29th May 1835

Capt Matthews

Dear Sir enclosed I send you
the execution against Bodfish
which I want you should
put into an officers hands and
give him directions to close it
I am willing to take a good
pay off in 34 months - Capt Bod
fish has refused to pay it but now
refuses. If Bodfish
has any property attachable I want
the officer to take it immediately
it was a service debt of honour
I now want it closed if you
will attend to it I will pay your
Bill. I have stoped some of your boys
which I suppose is as you expect
we shall earn more trading next week
and if you do not object shall send off yours
with others which I have purchased
I have purchased Lennans & Coles
old boys - if you are arriving on the
river I hope you will pay some attention
to them I lest write me an oblige yours
