With pleasure I took from the office, this morning three letters, forwarded by you. This, although I had before thought of writing to you as soon as an opportunity presented, aroused me to improve a few moments of this lowering day, in obedience to the commands of my desires. Jackson and I after, a very pleasant walk, and the enjoyment of a few very interesting rural scenes, which occurred on the way, arrived at Clinton where we found, waiting our order, a servant, a lad about fifteen years of age, with a prime horse and vehicle, thence we weighed anchor and kept our course North due East untill we bore in sight of the far famed Burnham where we put into port, and held a short conference with the ladies and contrary to our expectations were highly entertained, and truly edified, so much so that Yang really proposed hauling down all sail and laying to under bare pole for
