

Frankfort Sept 26. 1855

Sir

A gentleman has mentioned to me as probable that I could obtain from you some account of the Country that lies between the forks of the Northwest branch of the Pinobscat and the head waters of the river St. Johns. I will state my object. There is now considerable stir about a railroad to Dubuc. It is my opinion the proposed improved communication between our Coast and Dubuc ought to be by a railroad to Moosehead Lake, thence through the Lake <sup>head of the</sup> by steam and a canal from the Lake to the Chaudiere river, or from the forks of the Pinobscat if it be practicable to pass steam boats into the Pinobscat river <sup>by locks and a canal</sup> and to make a slack water navigation to the forks, or has
