

Frankfort Sept 26. 1835

A gentleman has mentioned to me as probable that I could obtain from you some account of the Country that lies between the forks of the edorthest branch of the Penobscot and the head waters of the river St. Johns.

I will state my object. There is now considerable stir about a railroad to Duber. It is my opinion the proposed improved connection between our Coast and Duber ought to be by a railroad to Moosehead Lake, thence through the Lake ~~by steam~~ <sup>and</sup> ~~the~~ and a canal from the Lake to the Chaudiere river, or from the forks of the Penobscot if it be practicable to pass steam boats into the Penobscot river by locks and a canal and to make a slack water navigation to the forks, or has been suggested.
