 were any Meeting for that purpose until  
 last Saturday, when Mrs Keiker handed  
 Me her License to Record, and I could  
 not inform you of it, within the 30 Day  
 specified by Law, the form of the License  
 is of following tenor to wit  
 Washington p, License hereby granted, to Mrs  
 Susan, & Gleason, ~~residents~~ as Suitable Persons  
 for inholders; under the following Restrictions,  
 that you must not furnish any of the inholders,  
 of the Town with any Spirits, of any kind, only  
 when necessary for Medicine, and you will not  
 suffer any Person, to be about your house, who  
 is ~~not~~ intemperate, at any time, Traveiler, or  
 Stranger, and you will Regard the Law also
