

Saco Sept 30th 1841

Dear Sir

I received yours of the third inst,  
by the hand of Mr Jordan with forty dollars  
your Bill against Daniel Cole (of five dollars)  
I have collected by pursuing after him a num-

me to keep the money, you wished  
me to ask him about the land I did he

it as to Mr Browns, Bill against him I  
dont recollect you must do as you think  
is right in this case and all others
