My last should have been dated the 2^d. you will please find 3 notes
the 600 against Mr Drew he agrees to pay when due if he should not
Please have it protested the other 400 he renews for 4 months by paying
you the interest of the present note and paying you 8 dollars bonus and a note
for 400 in 4 months with interest unless he prefers to advance the interest on the
same the other is yours you know all about it you will have \$12,40, 00
to invest Bond 900 the balance 3,40 please to invest in the Fitchburg
Rail Road stock old stock unless you see a better investment if so improve
it I am unacquainted altogether with this cheshire Rail Road this
land I hold says that stock holders private property is not holden
for the payment of these Bonds I dont know what makes any matter
I expect they are safe enough although I know nothing of the Road
Please write me in reference of the same you will know whether it
is a perfectly safe investment or not of course you would not
buy if it was not if you think Boston and Maine is better stock than
the Fitchburg you may buy 3 shares of the same please write as
soon as you receive this so I may know all is right and give me
a description of the cheshire Rail Road and what dividends they
make I am so ignorant about the road I dont know where
it is
