

Saco Oct 29<sup>th</sup> 1850

Dear Sir

I much regret not seeing you when lately in town. I returned today with my family - my little girl much improved by the journey & all well. Mr Tufts showed me the account of the Committee who I will hand to the Trustees tomorrow if possible - Is there not some mistake as to the dinner item? If I counted correctly there were from 65 to 70 in the room we were in - I do not know how many elsewhere but I understood the tables were full besides this some of our Life Members & other members went in soon afterwards with their ladies & did I paid their 50cts each especially because they feared there would be a deficit & hoped thus to make it up - several spoke to me about it remarking that they received the impression that they were were not included among those dined as "the Society" & wished me to see that all was made right about it - Perhaps I should have written you with regard to it
